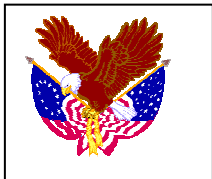

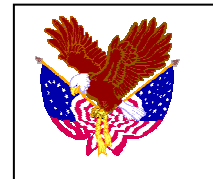

Postmark Deadline: April 1, 2008

Guidelines:

- Only student entries will be permitted. Eligible students are those who are currently enrolled in 6th – 12th grade in the current school year.
- Students may work alone or in teams of two. Only one entry per student/team will be accepted.
- Teachers and school support staff may be used to help with the technical aspects of creating the video. HOWEVER, all creative elements of the video must be created by the students.
- Video entries should be at least one minute long and no longer than five minutes.
- No graphic violence, nudity, or otherwise inappropriate material. FLREA reserves the right to disqualify any entrant who does not conform to this rule.
- Video entries must be submitted in one of the following formats: AVI, WMV, MOV
- To enter, **the video file must be written to a CD for entry.** No DVD entries please.
- Video entries must be no larger than 500 megabytes.
- Students must also submit a one paragraph description of how the video reflects the theme.
- All entries should be postmarked no later than April 1, 2008 for state judging and submitted to:

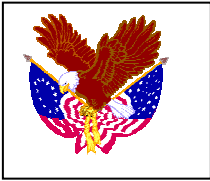

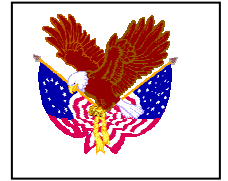

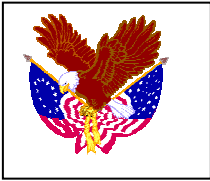
