## Requirements and Instructions

### Requirements:

Any high school junior or senior student is eligible for the program, provided he or she has not previously been a delegate to the program, and is currently serving in an elected capacity in any of the following student government, civic, or educational organizations:

- A. Student body president, vice-president, secretary, or treasurer.
- B. Class president, vice-president, secretary, or treasurer.
- C. Student Council representative
- D. Student representative to a district, regional or state-level civic education organization.

Permanent residency in the United States and enrollment in a Florida public or private school is required.

### Instructions:

To be eligible for consideration for this program, please complete the following:

- A. Complete the attached application form (must be typed) **(Part I)**
- B. Attach an official copy of the high school transcript. This must include a listing of the current courses that the student is enrolled in. **(Part II)**
- C. Provide no more than three letters of recommendation. **(Part III)**
